Beyond that, the investigation determined that Mr. Jamison engaged more egregious conduct than was previously disclosed. The report also offered recommendations for improved reporting of inappropriate behavior in State government.

In a press release following the publication of the report, Governor Reynolds said: "In his report, Mr. Weinhardt suggested that our policy should be clearer when it comes to making harassment complaints against a director. We will immediately take up this issue and make that change."
